How will my child receive instruction and assignments during Distance Learning?

If you have internet access at your home:

- Your child will complete online learning using a Learning Management System (LMS) called CANVAS.
- Getting to CANVAS
 - Log in to student Gmail account (link can be found on the school website)
 - In the upper right hand corner of the screen, click on the “waffle”  and then the CANVAS icon .
 - From the CANVAS homepage, students can access their courses, teacher calendars, resources, and complete/turn in assignments. .
- Teachers will host live meetings each day.

If you do not have daily internet access:

- Your child will complete remote learning using a USB drive that will be downloaded with instruction each week
- **The first USB drive pick-up will be on Tuesday, September 8 from 8am-4pm.** If this is an issue, please contact your principal.
- Each week, the student’s USB drive will need to be dropped off and a new one picked up on **Mondays** from 8am-4pm. If this is ever an issue, please contact your principal.
- The USB drive will contain each teacher’s weekly instruction, videos, assignments, and a weekly calendar.
- Completed student work will be saved to the USB drive.
- How to open files on a USB drive with the Chromebook:
 1. Plug the USB drive into port on the side of the Chromebook
 2. A window will pop up in the lower right hand corner of the screen – click OPEN FILES APP
 3. All of your student’s instruction will be in a folder named with the upcoming week’s dates
- Work completed will automatically save to the USB drive (make sure to put student name on every assignment).
- Remote learners may call in by phone to teacher live meetings each day. The call in information will be on the flash drive in each teacher’s weekly calendar.

All Distance Learners, whether online or remote, are expected to follow their regular class schedule each day, complete class assignments each day, attend as many live meetings as possible, and respond to teacher emails/phone calls in a timely manner.
